Bidders may be present during opening of tenders.

NSCD shall also not be bound to accept merely the lowest tender but the technical suitability, capability and superiority of the equipment / system as well as after sales service including infrastructure to render such service, etc. shall be of prime consideration for selection of the equipment /system.

General Information and Instructions

- 1. The instruction given herein will be strictly binding on the tenderers and deviation, if any will make the tender or tenders liable to be considered invalid. <u>Tenders incorporating additional conditions by the tenderer are liable for rejection.</u>
- 2. Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <u>https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u> Manual bids shall not be accepted.
- 3. The instruction given in "Annexure-A" for "Instruction for Online Bid Submission" should be strictly followed during submission of the Bid.
- 4. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- 5. Bid should be submitted along with the Earnest Money Deposit of ₹2,000/-(Rupees Two Thousand Only) through NEFT/RTGS in the account of National Science Centre as per Annexure F or by way of crossed Demand Draft / Pay Order on any nationalized bank of India payable in favour of "NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE, Payable at DELHI". Earnest Money deposit in the form of Bank Guarantee /Bond or any other instrument shall not be accepted and shall be rejected straightway. Earnest Money deposits in respect of such offers which are not accepted will be returned to the bidders within 30 working days from the date on which the final decision is taken about the source from which the items under tender are to be procured or within 2 (two) months from the date of the opening of the tenders, whichever is earlier. No interest will be paid on the Earnest Money deposited with the Council. Earnest Money deposit in respect of the successful bidders will be retained with the NSCD until entire execution of the order as per terms of the tender. If the successful bidder fails to execute the order strictly as per the NSCD's specification in full or part within the stipulated delivery period of the purchase order, the Earnest Money deposit retained with the NSCD shall be forfeited forthwith after cancellation of the concerned order. In case of non-receipt of EMD, the Tenders are liable to be rejected.
- 6. Validity of Bids: The Bids should remain valid for 90 days from the date of bid opening.
- 7. **Rejection of Bids:** Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and posttender correction may invoke summary rejection. Conditional tenders will be rejected. Non-compliance of applicable General Information and Instruction will disqualify the Bid.
- 8. The tenderers should have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for filling up the Bids. The Person signing the tender documents should be authorized for submitting the on line e-tender.
- 9. The Financial Bid (BOQ) shall be filled in and signed by the authorized signatory online as per Proforma "Annexure-G" available at Central Public Procurement Portal e-tender system website <u>http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>. Off line Financial Bid shall not be accepted.
- 10. Tender must be uploaded on-line in two separate sets namely Set 1 (Technical on Central Public Procurement Portal. The contents of Cover shall be as follows:-

<u>Set - 2</u>

i) The Financial Bid (as per Annexure-G) i.e. Schedule of Price Bid in the form of attached BOQ Proforma shall be duly filled in, digitally signed and uploaded online by the bidder.

N.B. : The bidders shall consider the prevailing tax rates while quoting the rates. However, in the event of any changes in the statutory taxes and duties, the rates applicable at the time of payment shall be made by the competent authority of the NSC, Delhi against submission of supporting documentary evidence.

- 11. Order shall be placed in favour of the bidder whose technical bid is acceptable and offered lowest rate for overall work as per BOQ in Annexure G.
- 12. The authority of National Science Centre, Delhi who does not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning and reason whatsoever.

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Instructions for Online Bid Submission

- 1. The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.
- 2. More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at <u>https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>

REGISTRATION

 Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <u>https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>) by clicking on the link

"Online bidder Enrollment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.

- 2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS /e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- 4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 3) Bidders should submit the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. The original instrument should be posted/couriered/given in person to the Tender processing Section at the above address, latest by the last date of bid submission. The detail of the Demand Draft / any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- 4) A standard Price Schedule format (BOQ) has been provided with the tender document to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the Light Blue colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- 5) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

- 6) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers public keys.
- 7) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 8) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- 9) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (GTC) FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDER FOR NON-COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE CONTRACT OF DIGITAL FIRE ALARM SYSTEM AT KURUKSHETRA PANORAMA & SCIENCE CENTRE, KURUKSHETRA

- 1. Bidders should have necessary infrastructure and facilities so as to take up the above work strictly as per enclosed specifications with required financial capability.
- 2. Tenders which do not fulfill all or any of these conditions or are incomplete in any respect, are liable to summary rejection without assigning any reason.
- 3. Tenders incorporating additional conditions are liable to be rejected.
- 4. Before quoting the AMC charges the agency must assess the quantum of work involved after going through the work and physical inspection of the equipment / site.
- 5. While submitting tenders the agencies must note that there will be no revision/ increase in the tendered rate on any ground whatsoever during the entire tenure of the contract. Therefore, they should include all eventual increases in statutory liabilities while quoting their offers.
- 6. During the period of this contract, the Agency shall provide proper and adequate service and perform their duties diligently, honestly and to the entire satisfaction of the Centre, The Agency shall constantly keep in touch with the Center for effective performance of the contract and abide by all instruction and directives issued by the Centre in this regard.
- 7. The Annual Maintenance Contract should be non-comprehensive type. Parts used for replacement of defective ones will be reimbursed separately as per the rates quoted by the party. The rates of the spares once quoted by the party shall be valid for at least one year and shall not be changed under any circumstances.
- 8. Party shall provide monthly regular preventive maintenance service before 10th of every month and will attend breakdown calls immediately. Failure to attend a call within 3 hours of receipt of complaint and to set right the fault within 24 hours will be treated as default of the contract.
- 9. The Centre shall pay to the Agency nothing more than the amount as may be due under the contract terms.

10. **PRICE**:

The rates indicated/quoted shall be inclusive of cost of materials, supply and all incidental charges to execute the work at **KURUKSHETRA PANORAM AND SCIENCE CENTRE**, **PEHOWA ROAD, KURUKSHETRA - 136118**. GST and any other taxes/levies to be imposed on the rate shall be clearly mentioned. Price and rate quoted shall be firm and fixed for the entire period of execution of the order and no escalation of rate on any ground whatsoever shall be applicable.

- 11. The successful bidder shall submit the following documents within 3 (Three) days from the date of Placement of the order:
 - i) Duplicate copy of the order duly signed and stamped as a token of acceptance of the order.
 - ii) Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value for preparing the agreement governing the terms and conditions of the Contract.
 - iii) Security Deposit @ 10% of the gross value of the work order.

12. PENALTY CLAUSE:-

Delay without satisfactory justification will be calculated from the date and time of reporting the fault to the contractor. In case of delay in rectification of the fault beyond 48 hours, a penalty of Rs.100/- per day per fault on Digital Fire Alarm System will be levied.

In case of delay in rectification of the fault beyond 7 days, the penalty of Rs.200/- per day per fault will be levied. In such an event, NSCD may get the faults rectified by third party and such cost of repairs shall have to be borne by the contractor, in addition to the penalty. In case contractor fails to pay the penalty and/or cost of the repairs (by third party) it shall be deducted from the security deposit/bill. The total penalty during the period of AMC, in each order, under this contract, shall not be more than 10% of the concerned order value. More than one half of a day shall be treated as a day.

13. PAYMENT TERMS:-

No advance payment shall be made by the Centre on any circumstances. Payment for the AMC shall be made on quarterly basis through RTGS/NEFT/TT/etc. within **30** (**Thirty**) working days from the date of receipt of pre-receipted Tax-Invoice in duplicate and on satisfactory completion of service. Invoice should be submitted indicating the Name of the Banker, IFSC Code, Account number, RTGS and Swift number of the banker, etc. for releasing e-payment to the agency.

14. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The Security Deposit shall be 10% of the gross value of the order which is to be paid in the form Bank Draft/Banker's cheque by the tenderer drawn in favour of National Science Centre, Payable at Delhi. The Security Deposit of the successful tenderer shall be released after expiry of the Contract satisfactorily. In case the total value of order exceeds the assessed value of the work order, security deposit for the excess amount will also be deducted. No interest shall be paid on the security deposit retained with this Centre.

- 15. Before quoting the AMC charges the agency must assess the quantum of work involved after going through the work and physical inspection of the equipment / site.
- 16. The equipment to be supplied by the bidder shall conform to the technical specifications given by the Centre.
- 17. If it is noticed that the goods supplied do not conform to the technical specification of the order, the Centre shall have the right to reject the materials in part or full. The supplier shall be liable to replace the rejected materials within the stipulated time. Till the replacement is done, the rejected materials shall be lying at the risk, cost and responsibility of the supplier.
- 18. In case the bidder refuse to accept the offer after finalization or does not comply with the Clause No.11 within 03 (Three) days from the date of placement of the order as per the finalized and accepted terms & conditions and the order shall be cancelled forthwith.
- 19. The authorities of the National Science Centre, Delhi have the right to amend, alter or modify the terms & condition mentioned above, if necessary, from time to time.
- 20. The authorities of National Science Centre, who does not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender, reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning and reason whatsoever.
- 21. The quantities specified in the tender may be decreased or increased at the sole discretion of NSCD authorities.
- 22. The agencies participating in the tenders & bidding may obtain on specific request, details about the outcome of the Tender and other related details, if any.

23. All disputes and differences between the successful bidder and the Centre of any kind except quality of workmanship and materials whatever arising out of or in connection with the order on carrying out the supply (whether during the progress of the work or after their completion and whether before or after the determination, abandonment or breach of the Terms & conditions of the order) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director General, National Council of Science Museums, whose decision in this regard will be final and binding on both the successful bidder and the Centre.

The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and of the rules made there under for the time being in force shall apply to arbitration's proceedings under this Clause.

24. The Centre shall pay to the Agency nothing more than the amount as may be due under the contract terms.

25. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- a) The Agency should be in existence for over 3 years in the field of Maintenance of Fire Alarm System. The service should be of more than Rs.3.00 lakh per annum during last 3 years. Documentary proof like balance sheet & Income Tax return, etc. should be attached.
- b) The firm should have previous experience in maintenance and repair of Fire Alarm System in Govt. Organization / PSUs. / Autonomous Bodies. Provide details of AMC performed during the last three years.
- c) While quoting AMC rates, base rate for individual items per year supported with taxes (GST) etc. shall be specifically mentioned in Financial Bid.

VALIDITY:

- 26. The contract may be renewed at the discretion of the Centre on year to year basis for a maximum period of three years. However, in the event of such renewal of the contract each year, if there is any revisions in the unit price of the spares then prior approval for the revised rates of the spares have to be taken from the higher authorities of the Centre.
- 27. The contract can be terminated by the Centre at any time without notice in the event of gross damage to Centre's property due to agency's failure or resistant failures of the Agency in providing satisfactory service to the Centre and the decision of the Centre in this regard shall be final and binding on the Agency.
- 28. For reasons other than mentioned in the clause above, the contract can be terminated by either party by providing clear three months' notice in writing.

29. DELAYS IN CONTRACTOR'S PERFORMANCE

Delay by the Contractor in the performance of its contractual obligations regarding performance of services shall render the Contractor liable to any or all of the following sanctions:

- a) Penalty/cost of repairs as per Clause mentioned above.
- b) Forfeiture of its Security Deposit
- c) Termination of the contract for default. The termination of the contract for default shall be at risk and responsibility of the contractor.
