1. The instructions given herein will be strictly binding on the bidders and deviation if any will make the tender or tenders liable to be considered invalid. Tenders incorporating additional conditions by the bidder are liable for rejection.
2. Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> Manual bids shall not be accepted.
3. The instructions given in “**Instruction for Online Bid Submission**” should be strictly followed during submission of the Bid.
4. Bid documents may be scanned at 100 dpi with a black and white option which helps in reducing the size of the scanned document.
5. **The validity of Bids: The Bids should remain valid for 120 days from the date of opening of the financial bid.**
6. **Rejection of Bids:** Canvassing by the Bidder(s) in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summarily rejection of their bid(s). Conditional tenders will also be rejected. Noncompliance of applicable General Information and Instructions will disqualify the Bid.
7. The Bidders should have a Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for filling up the Bids. The person signing the tender documents should be authorized for submitting the online e-tender.
8. The Bidders shall fill up the Prescribed Format for submission of **Technical (Techno-commercial) Bid as per “Annexure-A”** format duly signed by the authorized signatory. The person signing the tender document should be authorized for submitting the online e-tender.
9. The Financial Bid shall be filled in and signed by the authorized signatory online as per Format “**Annexure-B**” available at **Central Public Procurement Portal** e-tender system website <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. **Offline Financial Bid shall not be accepted.**
10. Tender must be uploaded in two separate covers marked **Cover-1** (Technical Bid/ (Techno-commercial bid) and **Cover-2** (Financial Bid/BOQ and Cost breakup). The contents of Cover-1 and Cover-2 shall be as follows:-

Cover-1: It shall contain

- i. “**Technical (Techno- commercial) Checklist**” document as detailed in **Annexure-A** duly filled in and digitally signed with an official stamp.
- ii. All relevant supporting documents related to “**Technical (Techno-commercial) Bid**” As per “**Annexure-A**”.
- iii. The scanned copy of Bill of Quantities (**Annexure-G**), General Terms & Conditions etc. duly signed by the Authorized Signatory with the official stamp as a token of acceptance of the same by the bidders.
- iv. Proof of submission of EMD/Bid Security (or) Bid Security Declaration & MSME registration certificate copy (in case of exemption claimed by the bidder under MSME).
- v. Other relevant and mandatory undertakings etc. as detailed in the document.

Cover-2: It shall contain

The **Cover-1**, i.e. Technical (Techno-commercial) Bid shall be opened by NSCD at the first instance and evaluated by the duly constituted Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC). At the second stage, the **Cover -2** containing Financial Bid (of only techno-commercially acceptable) offers shall be opened for further evaluation.

Clarification in Public Interest

It has been brought to our attention that certain unscrupulous elements are circulating fraudulent emails purporting to be from “NCSM”/“NCSM India”/“NSC Delhi”. These emails attempt to mislead recipients into depositing money under the following pretexts:

These emails are fraudulently attributed to NCSM/NCSM India/ NSC Delhi/ Recruitment Team.

NCSM/NCSM India/NSC, Delhi has not issued any such emails. Please note that **NCSM, as per established policy, does not ask for any money other than those mentioned in the e-tender documents** to be deposited through any of the methods mentioned in the E-Tender document while submitting the bid online.

These deceptive communications often use IDs or domain names resembling those of NCSM or/and constituent units viz. National Council of Science Museums (NCSM)/**National Science Centre, Delhi (NSC, Delhi)**/Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai (NSC, Mumbai)/Visvesvaraya Industrial & Technological Museum, Bangalore (VITM, Bangalore)/Birla Industrial & Technological Museum, Kolkata (BITM, Kolkata)/Science City, Kolkata/National Science Centre, Guwahati (NSC, Guwahati) (*or a deceptively similar name*) to make it look authentic. NCSM is taking appropriate measures to address this issue.

All tenderers and bidders are advised to remain vigilant and take note of the following indicators of fraudulent communication:

- NCSM/NSC Delhi does not request any payment from tenderers/bidders during the e-tendering process except for the officially prescribed Tender Fee/EMD payable through mentioned methods.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

1. The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submit their bids online on the CPP Portal.
2. More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>

A. REGISTRATION

- i. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/> app) by clicking on the link “Online Bidders Enrolment” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- ii. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- iii. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- iv. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.) with their profile.
- v. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC’s to others which may lead to misuse.
- vi. Bidders may then log-in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID/password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

B. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- i. There are various search options built-in the CPP Portal to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- ii. Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents/tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective ‘My Tenders’ folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- iii. The bidders should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification/help from the Helpdesk.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

- i. Bidders should take into account the original e-NIT/RFP and any subsequent corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.

- ii. Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the documents that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
Bidders, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with a black and white option which helps in reducing the size of the scanned document.
- iii. To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use the “My Space” or “Other Important Documents” area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the “My Space” area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for the bid submission process.

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- i. Bidders should log-into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidders will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- ii. The bidders have to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- iii. A standard Price Schedule format (BOQ) has been provided with the tender document to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file (rate quote sheet), open it and complete the blue colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as the name of the bidders). No other cells should be changed. In case no rate value is required to be quoted in any particular cell, that cell may be kept blank, figure ‘0’ (zero) shall not be entered in such cell(s). Once the details have been completed, the bidders should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidders, the **bid will be rejected**. In addition to the above, the Cost Break-up shall be submitted in tabular format duly digitally signed with an official stamp.
- iv. The server time (which is displayed on the bidders’ dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- v. All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of the bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is

subjected to symmetric encryption using a system-generated symmetric key. Further, this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid opener's public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

- vi. The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- vii. Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message and a bid summary will be displayed with the bid number and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- viii. The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (GTC) FOR SUBMISSION OF E-TENDER

Name of the work: Fabrication and installation of FRP models, reinforced artwork and all related works required for setting up the Human Biology Gallery at NSC-Delhi.

1. INTRODUCTION

National Science Centre Delhi, the northern zone head office of the National Council of Science Museums, Ministry of Culture, Government of India invites offers/ bids from reputed and experienced agencies for undertaking the subject work at **National Science Centre, Delhi** as per the laid down specifications and terms of the tender.

2. BACKGROUND

The primary objective of the project is to serve as an enlightening space, where visitors can delve into the wonders of the human biology. It aims to present the comprehensive narrative of Biology in a simple and accessible manner, offering scientific viewpoints that are easy to grasp.

The Estimated Project Cost (EPC) shall be about **Rs. 24,75,000/-** including GST. This cost includes the cabinet fabrication, wall paneling, FRP models, thematic illuminated ceiling and installation of various other components along with their interiors of the Project Facilities within the specified timelines. The EPC is inclusive of 1 year of defect liability period (DLP).

Note: Cost estimate is indicative in nature, and the Bidders are required to carry out independent evaluation, verification, and assessment prior to quoting the Financial Bid.

3. BIDDING & SELECTION PROCESS

1. The complete bidding documents (the “Bidding Documents”) and any addenda/corrigenda issued subsequent to this RFP will be deemed to form part of the Bidding Documents.
2. The Authority has adopted an online Single-Stage two envelop system (collectively the “Selection Process”) for evaluating the Bids/Proposals comprising technical and financial proposals to be submitted online through e-tendering as mentioned CPP portal . In the first step, the Technical Bids of all Bidders shall be evaluated whether they meet the Minimum Eligibility Criteria set forth in **Clause 4** of this GTC for undertaking the Project and their responsiveness. Once it is determined that the Bid is responsive and Bidder fulfills the Minimum Eligibility Criteria, these eligible bidders will be required to make presentation before the Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC). Marks shall be allocated based on the eligibility criteria and presentation. Only those Bidders who score a minimum 75 marks out of 100 in Technical evaluation shall be entitled to opening of their Financial Bid subject to and in accordance with provisions set out under this RFP. The successful bidder will be selected on the least cost system based on their financial bids.

Note: Technical Bids will be evaluated on the basis of documents as detailed above &

Presentations to be made by the eligible agencies before the TEC. The date and time of the presentations will be conveyed to the eligible agencies.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- i. Individuals, Limited Company /Corporation, Proprietary/ Partnership firms, Consortium/ Joint Venture (Maximum 2 members) are allowed to bid for the work. Submit company registration certificate and/or JV agreement etc.
- ii. Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest (the “Conflict of Interest”) that affects the Bidding Process and submit a declaration in this regard. Any Bidder found to have a Conflict of Interest (at a later date) shall be disqualified. In the event of disqualification, the Authority shall be entitled to forfeit and appropriate the Bid Security and cancel the order (if placed).

Without prejudice to any other right or remedy that may be available to the Authority under the Bidding Documents and/or the Agreement or otherwise. A Bidder shall be deemed to have a Conflict of Interest affecting the Bidding Process, if:

- a) A constituent of such Bidder is also a constituent of another Bidder; However, this clause shall not apply in case of Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) is supplying the equipment’s through various authorized/dealer/distributors or
 - b) Such Bidder receives or has received any direct or indirect subsidy, grant, concessional loan or subordinated debt from any other Bidder, or has provided any such subsidy, grant, concessional loan or subordinated debt to any other Bidder, its member; or
 - c) Such Bidder has the same legal representative for purposes of this Application as any other Bidder; or
 - d) Such Bidder has participated as a Bidder to the Authority in the preparation of any documents, design or technical specifications of the Project.
- iv) No agency or current employees of the Authority shall work as the Bidders under their own ministries, departments, or agencies. A declaration to be submitted to this effect in **Annexure – J**.
- v) A Bidder should have, during the last three years, neither failed to perform on any agreement, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitral or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the Bidder, nor been expelled from any project or agreement nor have had any agreement terminated for breach by such Bidder. The bidder must not have been blacklisted/debarred by any Government/Semi Government Organization or Corporation in India at any stage in last five years. **The bidder is required to submit declaration in this respect on an Affidavit of Rs. 100/- Stamp paper.**
- vi) The Bidder should submit a Power of Attorney as per the format at **Annexure-F.1**.
- vii) **General Eligibility – the agency should have** valid registrations such as PAN, GST, EPF and ESI Registration of the participating firm/lead firm. Submit copies of these documents.

viii) The bidder (the lead partner in case of consortium/JV) should be in existence for at least 5 years in similar business as on the date of publication of this RFP. Submit a copy of registration certificate and work order to confirm the existence for 5 years.

ix) Financial Capacity :

- a. Turnover: The Bidder shall have minimum Average Annual Turnover of Rs. 50 lakh (Rupees fifty lakh only) during any 3 (three) financial years in the past 5 financial years issued duly **certified by the Chartered Accountant** (FY 2020-2021, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25).
- b. Net worth: Bidder shall have net worth of Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakh only) as on 31st March 2025.
- c. Income Tax Return Certificate: Bidder has to upload last 3 financial years ITR Certificate.

Note: The Bidder must submit, with its Technical Proposal, the documentary evidence regarding fulfillment of all the above criteria.

x) **Similar Work Experience:** The Bidder should have completed (Ref format **Annexure – D and ensure to submit work order copies as well as completion certificates**) similar works during the past 3 years:

- a. **1 (One)** similar work (in Central Government/ Central Autonomous Bodies/ State PWD/ Central Public Sector Undertakings) of value not less than 80% of the estimated cost.

OR

- b. **2 (Two)** similar works (at least one of them should be in Central Government / Central Autonomous Bodies/ State PWD / Central Public Sector Undertakings) each value not less than 50% of the estimated cost.

OR

- c. **3 (Three)** similar works (at least one of them should be in Central Government / Central Autonomous Bodies/ State PWD/ Central Public Sector Undertakings) each value not less than 40% of estimated cost.

Note: 1. Similar Works means Fabrication, Supply and Installation of Permanent Exhibitions / Interpretation Centre works/ Museum /Museums of permanent nature with the nature of work involved like cabinet fabrication and FRP artistic model Works etc.

xi. The agency should have technical expertise in the field of artists for developing desired quality of FRP models, interior (specialized in corian (solid surfaces) works) experts in their rolls or collaborations. Details of all these technical experts (either on their rolls or have collaborations with professionals/agencies of this specialization) need to be submitted along with the details of the works done by them. Ref: **Annexure – D.**

xii. Agency should have sufficient physical infrastructure of the agency, their

workshop, manpower, (either in-house or collaborators) to execute works of this nature in short durations. Provide details on letterhead with supporting documents/tie-ups with agencies etc.

The bidder should submit supporting documents in support of their eligibility criteria and other details as per the formats provided in the annexures.

Notes:

- i. In the case of Consortium/JV participating in this RFP, the works of all the individual members of the Consortium/JV done independently (not in JV/consortium with other agency) will be considered as valid work experience.
- ii. *If any bidder has executed the similar work as a part of a consortium/JV in the past then the work experience of the bidder shall be considered as valid only if all the consortium/JV partners are participating together in the present RFP also.*
- iii. The details of qualifying works/projects shall be furnished as per the proforma in **Annexure – C** and if required, the bidder shall also facilitate inspection of the above qualifying project(s) by NSCD's officials to ascertain the performance of the system.
- iv. The bidder should submit copy/copies of the work order(s) issued in the name of the agency as well as copies of work completion certificate of the same work, clearly indicating the value of the work of similar nature. If the work order contains several works, only the value of the works of a similar nature shall be considered for work experience. If the value of the works of similar nature is not specifically mentioned in the cost breakup, the work experience against that work order will not be considered as valid.
- v. NSCD may inspect any of those works at its discretion to verify the credentials of the bidder for the qualifying works/ projects indicated above for which the Bidder shall provide references (including Referee names and contact details) in respect of the projects implemented.
- vi. The bidder should provide documentary proof to clearly substantiate each eligibility criteria, failing which the bid will be summarily rejected.
- vii. Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they likely to be disqualified or orders to be (if placed) cancelled if they have:
 - Made misleading or false representation in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
 - Record for poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history etc.

5. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT/ BID SECURITY

Earnest Money Deposit for the tender is Rs. **75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand only)**. The EMD should be deposited in the form of Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker's Cheque of any Nationalized /Scheduled Bank or Bank Guarantee (valid for 6

months from the last date of submission of tender) drawn in favour of National Science Centre, Delhi payable at Delhi. Alternatively the EMD may also be paid through RTGS/NEFT to the bank account of National Science Centre, Delhi before the last date of submission of tenders. In case of payment of EMD through physical instrument, the physical instrument should be physically submitted at the office of National Science Centre Delhi on any working day between 10.00 AM and 5.00 PM before and up to the last date of submission of the filled-in tender documents and attach a copy of the receipt/physical instrument submitted as proof of submission in the technical documents in Part – 1. In case of online transfer, the transfer should be affected by or before the last date of submission and the proof of submission of the same should be uploaded in pdf format in the technical bid in Part-1.

Agencies claiming eligibility for EMD exemption should submit declaration on registration as MSME (Submit a copy of MSME Registration certificate in Technical documents) and Bid Securing Declaration Form (Annexure-I). In absence of these documents and EMD, the bid will be summarily rejected.

The EMD, in case received, shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders within 4 weeks of finalization of the tender. In case of the successful tenderer, this will become part of the Security Deposit / Performance Guarantee and the same will be refunded after successful completion and lapse of Defect Liability Period.

6. SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The successful bidder shall be responsible for thoroughly studying the drawings, rendered images (https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/17SSF_XeV5f27ZhZYbB8FAIBwbFtVU0er?usp=sharing), site conditions etc. and submit their quotes/rates. It shall be the responsibility of the agency to engage skilled manpower to deliver the required quality of interiors, FRP finishes etc. The agency shall seek any clarifications on the drawings/processes/finishes/makes etc. in advance and arrange all the required materials, men, tools & tackles to ensure timely completion of the project.

As and when required, the agency shall arrange for inspection of the artworks, FRP models, lighting effects etc. before finalization. The agency shall be responsible for getting

the digital prints of best quality on different media and proper installation of the same at site. The agency shall engage professional lighting experts to ensure best lighting effects in the exhibition.

As the work being executed is for a permanent exhibition, utmost care to be taken regarding the strength of structures to ensure their durability owing to interactive usage by the visitors. It is to be noted that utmost care to be taken at site while executing the fabrication works not to cause any damage to the existing facilities/finishes. In case of any damage caused, the same needs to be rectified to original finish by the agency at their own risk and cost.

The successful bidder shall dismantle and remove the existing panels and cabinets in the first enclave of the Human Biology gallery without causing any disturbance to visitors (if necessary, the work may be carried out after office hours). All dismantled materials must be transported out of the NSCD premises.

The successful bidder shall carry out and complete the works in every respect in accordance with this contract with the directions of the designated officers and to the satisfaction of the NSCD. The designated officers may from time to time issue further drawings and/or written instructions, detailed directions and explanations with regard to:

- a. The variation or modification of the design, quality or quantity of works for the addition or omissions or substitution of any work.
- b. Any discrepancy in the drawings or between the schedule of quantities and/or drawing and/or specifications.
- c. The removal from the site of any material brought therein by the successful e-tenderer and the substitution of any other materials therefrom.
- d. The removal and/or re-execution of any works executed by the successful bidder not conforming to the specs.
- e. The dismissal of any persons employed from the works.
- f. The opening up for the inspection of any work covered up.
- g. The amending and making good of any defects.
- h. The successful bidder shall comply with and duly execute any work comprising such instructions, detailed directions and explanations, provided always that if the Engineer's instructions involved variations from the priced Schedule of Quantities, such instructions shall be issued by the Centre and the successful e-tenderer shall take appropriate action.
- i. Even if not specifically mentioned in the schedule of quantities, the successful bidder shall be deemed to have allowed necessary material, labour, tools etc. required for satisfactory completion of the items of work as indicated in drawings and description given in the specifications, which are attached herewith unless the item specifies labour only or otherwise.
- j. Successful bidder to provide everything necessary**
The successful bidder shall provide everything necessary for the proper execution of the works according to the true intent and meaning of the design, drawings and specifications and bill of quantities taken together, whether the same may or may not

be particularly shown on the drawings or described in the specifications or included in the bill of quantities, provided that the same is to be reasonably inferred therefrom and if the bidder finds any discrepancy in the drawings, or between the drawings and specifications and bill of quantities, they shall immediately refer the same to the designated officer who shall decide which shall be followed. Figured dimensions shall be followed in reference to scale.

- k. **Rates:** The rates quoted by the Successful bidder shall be paid at net rates inclusive of GST and any other taxes. They should include in their rates allowance for increase or decrease in the prices due to market fluctuation. Bidder shall not be entitled to any separate amount on account of GST, other taxes, Labour Cess, duties etc. which are in force or will be enforced or enhanced by Government or local bodies during the contract period or after e-tendering. Accepted e-tender rates shall not be changed due to changes in wages of labour either.

l. Quantities

All the quantities given in the schedule of quantities are provisional and indicative. Bidders may prior to submitting their proposals, study the CAD drawings, FRP models, Technical specifications and obtain necessary clarifications regarding information for preparation of their proposal.

The bidder shall be deemed to have given balanced rates and quantities for each item with make, model and specification. Also irrespective of variation in quantities to any extent, the bidder shall be paid at accepted contract rates only. NSCD reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities to any extent.

7. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE/ RETENTION MONEY/ SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- i. This shall mean and be 7% of the total cost of work awarded.
- ii. PG amount, in excess of already deposited EMD, shall be submitted by the successful bidder before commencement of work upon placement of work order.
- iii. The Retention Money or Security Deposit so retained shall not carry any interest thereon.
- iv. The Retention Money or Security Deposit shall be refundable to the successful bidder after satisfactory completion of the Defects Liability Period post actual successful completion of the work in all respects & handing over as detailed under TERMS OF PAYMENT.
- v. A penalty in the form of deduction, as deemed fit by NSCD authority, shall be applied and be deductible from the Payment payable/ Retention Money/ Security Deposit of the bidder for any lapse in providing services, rectifying defects or in case of an inordinate delay in attending the faults/defects.
- vi. If the successful bidder fails to rectify the defects within a reasonable time, such defects will be rectified by NSCD by engaging departmental staff or outside Agencies at their discretion, and the cost thereof, as decided by NSCD will be deducted from the Retention Money / Security Deposit of the successful bidder retained by NSCD.
- vii. In case of termination of the contract due to reasons arising out of non-performance / improper performance of the contract by the successful bidder, this retention money

shall be forfeited and the amount necessary to make up this amount shall be recovered from any money due to the successful bidder under this or any other contract with NSCD.

- viii. In case, the successful bidder causes any damage to the property of the Client, the NSCD shall have discretionary rights to execute the repair of damages and recover the amount from the successful bidder or to adjust the equivalent amount from the successful bidder's Security Deposit.
- ix. In case of death of successful bidder, Security Deposit shall be returned /refunded to the legal heir of the successful bidder after adjustment of dues, if any, post the actual completion of the work & upon expiry of the specified guarantee/defects liability period.

8. PROPOSAL EVALUATION / SELECTION CRITERIA

The online bid (both Technical Bid and Financial Bid) should be uploaded by due date and time. The responsibility to ensure the same lies with the bidders. Off-line tenders shall not be accepted and no request in this regard will be entertained whatsoever. Online Technical Bids will be opened at the first instance in National Science Centre, Delhi as detailed in the Schedule for Technical Evaluation. In the second stage, the Financial Bids of only the qualified techno-commercial acceptable offers will be opened. Decision of the Centre, regarding selection of eligible and qualified vendors / firms for opening the Financial Bid shall be final and binding on the bidders. Bidders may be present during opening of tenders.

Order shall be placed in favour of the bidder whose technical bid is acceptable and offered overall lowest rate in as per Price Quoted in format given in **Annexure – B**.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any Proposal which is non-responsive and no request for alteration, modification, substitution, or withdrawal shall be entertained by the Authority in respect of such Proposals.

Notes:

1. Technical bids of the agencies that fulfill the above pre-qualification criteria shall be opened.
2. The bidder has to upload the compliance letter on its letterhead duly signed by the authorized signature & other supporting documents as asked for in the bid in scanned format. Failing to submit the same or non-compliance/deviation from any bid terms and conditions, eligibility criteria or technical specifications may result in rejection of the bid.

A. Technical Evaluation

The Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) appointed by the competent authority shall carry out its evaluation applying the eligibility evaluation criteria specified in the bid document. Evaluation of the application would be done as per the documents submitted by bidders/agencies. The agencies who fulfill the eligibility criteria will be communicated by email to make a presentation before the TEC on the aspects of their understanding of the project, execution methodology, expertise in creative artistic works & FRP models, integration of solid surfaces (corian) with FRP

cabinets, project planning and execution methodology for timely completion etc. The Technical Bids will be evaluated on these parameters which are as given in the table below:

Note: *Bidders who are awarded zero marks in any of the items from S. No. 1 to 5 will not be qualified for technical presentation (considering eligibility criteria). Bidders must get 70% in the technical for getting eligible for opening the financial bid.*

NOTE: NSC Delhi reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders in full or part without assigning any reason whatsoever. NSCD shall also not be bound to accept merely the lowest

tender but the technical suitability, capability and superiority of the equipment / system as well as after sales service including infrastructure to render such service, etc. shall be of prime consideration for selection of the equipment /system.

B. Financial Evaluation

- a. The Financial Bids of only the technically qualified bidders will be opened.
- b. Details of the taxes and duties applicable on the basic cost of development of items mentioned in BOQ must be indicated clearly in the financial bid.
- c. Order shall be placed in favour of the bidder whose technical bid is acceptable and offered overall lowest rate in as per Price Quoted in format given in **Annexure – C**.
- d. Errors & Rectification: Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis: “If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail”.

9. JOINT VENTURES / CONSORTIUM

In the event that the successful bidder is a consortium/joint venture formed, lead partner/ prime contractor in whose name LOI is issued shall be fully and solely responsible for the performance of contract and all works designed and executed under the contract.

Bids submitted by a consortium or joint venture of **maximum two firms including lead partner, all partners shall comply with the following requirements:**

- i. The consortium as a whole must be a sound entity technically and the lead partner must be a sound entity financially.
- ii. The Consortium as a whole must satisfy the qualification criteria set forth herein. The turnover of the lead partner must satisfy the eligibility criteria of the tender. The bid shall contain a statement of the members of the consortium and shall provide all information necessary to satisfy Client/Employer that the Consortium fulfills the qualifying criteria.
- iii. The Bids shall contain original copy of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Rs.100. Non-Judicial Stamp paper (or as applicable) between the consortium members clearly identifying the lead partner, scope and responsibility and financial part of each member in the performance of the contract.
- iv. The consortium members will obtain approval of the Client for any change in the shareholding, structure and scope of work or any other terms of MOU.
- v. The lead partner of the consortium shall be nominated as being in-charge to represent the Consortium in all dealings with the Client/Employer and for providing any information or clarification sought from the Consortium.
- vi. The Bid shall be signed by all the consortium firms by their authorized person. The lead partner shall be authorized to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all member(s) of the Consortium and all dealings including billing and payments, shall be done exclusively with the leader of the consortium.
- vii. Only firms or joint ventures that have been qualified under this procedure will be

eligible to bid for this project.

- viii. All members of the Consortium shall be liable for the execution of the project in accordance with the terms of the MOA and Contract agreement.
- ix. Any individual bidder or member of a consortium cannot be a member in another consortium and participate in this tender.
- x. All correspondence or communications will be done by the Lead partner (or authorized representative of Lead Partner) of the consortium.
- xi. Net worth as on the last day of the preceding financial year should be positive during the preceding three consecutive financial years.
- xii. Bidder submitting their bid shall not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceeding

10. COMPLETION TIME

The project / work is to be completed within **45 days** from the date of issuance of the work order/LOI.

11. AMENDMENT OF RFP

- a. At any time prior to the deadline for submission Bids/ Proposal, the Authority may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarifications requested by a Bidder, modify the RFP document by the issuance of Addendum/ Amendment.
- b. All such amendments will be uploaded on e-tendering website CPP Portal and will be binding on all Bidders.
- c. In order to afford the Bidders a reasonable time for taking an amendment into account, or for any other reason, the Authority may, in its sole discretion, extend the Proposal Due Date (PDD).

12. DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD.

Defect Liability Period (DLP) shall be of **ONE YEAR** from the date of actual satisfactory completion & handing over of the entire job as certified by the authorities of NSCD.

13. TERMS OF PAYMENT:

No advance payment shall be made by National Science Centre, Delhi under any circumstances. One interim payment shall be released at the discretion of the Centre. Final payment for the actual quantities of work done will be released within 30 (thirty) days from the date of receipt of Tax Invoice/Bill duly supported by receipted challan and satisfactory inspection and completion report/certification.

Note:

- i. In case the work is carried out in phases, total payment admissible will be computed on a pro-rata basis based on completed percent of work vis-à-vis total work under consideration.
- ii. All payments, as above, shall become payable within thirty days of submission of the respective invoices. The payment shall be transferred to the bank account of the successful bidder through electronic transfer only, for which the bank details of the bidder has to be

- provided with each invoice.
- iii. Statutory deductions/recoveries viz. TDS, GST, Labour cess, etc. shall be made as per the relevant provisions from the payment due to the bidder from time to time.
 - iv. NSCD reserves the right to foreclose the agreement at any stage by giving one-month notice, in case the performance is not upto required level or reminders not yielding results in specified time frame. In that case no further payment shall be paid to the Agency for the remaining stages of the work and no claim of this account will be entertained.

14. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a. The successful tenderer shall submit the following documents within **03 (Three)** working days from the date of placement of Letter of Intent.
 - Duplicate copy of the Purchase Order / LOI duly signed and stamped as a token of acceptance of the order.
 - Non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value for preparing the Agreement governing the terms and conditions of the Contract.
 - Performance Guarantee / Security Deposit as above.
- b. In case the successful bidder refuses to accept the offer after finalization or does not comply with sending of acceptance of the order within 03 (Three) days from the date of placement of the order as per the finalized and accepted terms & conditions, the order shall be cancelled forthwith and action will be initiated.
- c. The RFP and all its terms will be part of agreement between Museum / Centre and the successful tenderer.
- d. The contractor may visit the site & thoroughly understand the drawings and scope of work before quoting his rates in the tender and acquaint himself with site conditions thoroughly. No claims for additional payments would be entertained arising out of contractor's ignorance of site conditions.
- e. The rate quoted by the contractor shall include all labour, materials, tools & tackles, fixtures, etc. for executing and completing the work. He should also include in his rate all taxes including taxes on works contract, GST, freight, etc., and also should allow for fluctuations of market prices.
- f. The contractor shall arrange for water and electricity required at their own cost
- g. The contractor should quote balanced rate. Quantities given in the schedule are tentative and may vary up to any extent. The Museum/Centre reserves the right to execute or to delete any item or increase or decrease any quantity or quantities of the bill of quantities. Rates quoted in the tender shall be binding for all such variation in quantities.
- h. The contractor shall be responsible for the true and perfect setting out of works and also correctness of positions, levels, dimensions and alignment of all parts thereof. If any time any error arises the contractor shall rectify it at his own cost.
- i. All waste material, filth or other matters of offensive nature or which are of no use shall have to be removed from the premises by the contractor at his own cost on weekly basis and keep the work environment clean at all times.
- j. Materials to be used in the work shall conform to the prescribed norms. In absence of specifications, if any, I.S. specification should be followed and alternate should be got approved before using.

- k. National Science Centre will not be liable for any injury or death of an employee who is deployed by the successful bidder within/outside the work site during the time of execution of the work order.
- l. **Penalty Clause:** In case of non-completion of the entire work within the stipulated time, and the delay is not attributable to site requirements, Liquidated Damage (L.D.) @1% per week of the total cost of work awarded subject to a maximum of 10% of the gross value of work done or cost of work awarded, whichever is greater, shall be recovered from the bill of the successful bidder.
- m. The authorities of NSCD do not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- n. The quoted rate shall remain unchanged during the entire contract period till the completion of work.
- o. The successful bidder shall be liable for depositing all taxes, levies, cess, etc. on account of service rendered by them to concerned tax collection authorities from time to time as per extant rules and regulations on the matter.
- p. The successful bidder shall maintain all statutory registers under the applicable laws. They shall produce the same, on demand, to the concerned authority of this Office or any other authority under Law.
- q. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be affected, as and when applicable, as per the provisions of Income Tax Act, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the bidder/contractor/supplier by this Office.
- s. In case, the successful bidder fails to comply with any statutory/ taxation liability under appropriate law and as a result thereof this Office is put to any loss/ obligation, monetary or otherwise, this office (National Science Centre, Delhi) will be entitled to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the Security Deposit of the Agency, to the extent of the loss or obligation in monetary terms.
- t. Bidders should provide complete details of their local and other offices in Delhi/NCR.
- r. The successful bidder shall be required to depute a team of qualified and experienced personnel to coordinate, execute and supervise all the activities from commencement till completion and handing over the project. This team of personnel will also be required to monitor the progress and review in consultation with NSCD officials on a regular basis.
- s. **Bidders should provide an escalation matrix of their company for this project. Names of all the persons, contact details along with their designation should be submitted.**
- t. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, in case of any dispute, claim and/or legal action arising out of this contract, the same shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Delhi only.
- u. **Arbitration Clause:** All disputes and differences between the successful tenderer and the Council of any kind, except quality of workmanship and materials, whatever arising out of or in connection with the order on the carrying out of the work (whether during the progress of the work or after their completion and whether before or after the determination, abandonment or breach of the terms and conditions of the order) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director General,

National Council of Science Museums, whose decision in this regard will be final and binding on both the successful Tenderer and the Council.

- v. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification of the rules made there under for the time being in force shall apply to arbitration's proceedings under this Clause.
- w. **Force Majeure:** Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non-performance of any of its obligations (except for failure to pay any sum which has become due on account of receipt of goods under the provisions of the present contract), if the non-performance results from such Force Majeure circumstances as Flood, Fire, Earth Quake and other acts of God as well as War, Military operation, blockade, Acts or Actions of State Authorities or any other circumstances beyond the parties control that have arisen after signing of the present contract. In such circumstances the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the present contract is extended correspondingly for the period of time of action of these circumstances and their consequences.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE WORK

1. Introduction

A Human Biology Gallery spread across an area measuring approximately 1300 sq. ft. is to be set up at National Science Centre, Delhi. At present, the site is earmarked, completed with vitrified flooring, air-conditioning. Bulk electricity is also available at site. The present tender / RFP is to engage a capable agency to execute the designs at site which include Fabrication and installation of FRP models, reinforced artwork and all related works required for setting up the Human Biology Gallery at NSC-Delhi. The fabrication work is to be done with quality finish and workmanship. This document contains the technical specification for this work. Bidders are required to execute the work conforming to these technical specifications. In case of any unavoidable deviation, the same should be brought to the knowledge of the authorities of the Centre and the decision of the Centre shall be final in this regard.

Fabrication of the FRP artwork has to be executed in accordance with the following:

- a) Detailed Fabrication Drawings of the FRP artwork
- b) Computer aided 3D artistic model of the gallery.
- c) As per direction provided by site in-charge of National Science Centre, Delhi

While the drawings mentioned in (a) and (b) above are enclosed along with the technical specification. However, it may be noted that the exhibit sizes, location could be altered at the time of execution due to site conditions and requirements as per directions of site in-charge.

2. Materials used in fabrication

- a) **Reinforcement of FRP artwork:** The FRP artwork shall be reinforced using heavy-gauge more than 2.6mm MS tube metal frames (600x600mm) with a suitable section of 25x40mm, as per the technical specifications. These sections must be fully welded. After frame fabrication, a primer coat followed by a single coat of enamel paint should be applied.
- b) **Panels & Boards:** wherever Panels or Boards are required shall be made of WPC (Wood Plastic Composites) boards of 18 or 19 mm thickness of density 0.6 to 0.75 g/cm³ or plywood of 12mm thickness and make Century/Greenlam, BWR, E0 emissions (conforming to IS: 2046–1995) with laminate or paint finish as per technical specifications. The boards shall be fixed to the metal frames using self-tapping SS screws.
- c) **Corian finish** – All computer kiosks (only top surface), switch boxes, etc. shall be finished in Corian of appropriate thickness. FRP cabinets (top surface) housing TVs/monitors shall consist of an FRP shell with a solid surface (Corian) top. The integration between FRP and Corian must be seamless, with no visible joints. A concealed maintenance access panel (false cutout) shall be provided, with only a minimal, fine cut line visible.
- d) **Painting:** Painting shall be done by applying PU primer with putty finish and finally 2 to 3 coats of 1st quality PU paint of approved brand & shades with a **PU lacquer top coat**.
- e) The LED Strip Lighting and cool white (5000K) or warm white (3000K) as per requirement. The edge lightening should have dimmable function for adjustable brightness, high CRI (>90) for accurate color rendering, diffusion & anti-glare Treatment, acrylic

diffusers to eliminate harsh glare or hotspots, frosted glass panels for smooth light dispersion. The Energy-efficient LED drivers with low power consumption and Proper heat dissipation design should be there to ensure longevity for the gallery.

- f) **Adhesive and other hardware materials:** Adhesive and other hardware materials should be used as per technical specification or as approved by competent authority of NSCD.

3. Important Note for annexures H (From H -1 to H- 11):

- a. The bidder should ensure to provide the items mentioned in the **Annexure H** and its subsections.
- b. The bidder should ensure to achieve the quality and aesthetics of the gallery as referenced in the rendered images.
- c. Fiberglass (FRP - Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic) should have sufficient thickness to ensure durability.
- d. The bidder should ensure smooth finish with appropriate, support Structure with MS framework for strength and stability for the model /structure. While installation, proper anchoring to be ensured for structural integrity in an interactive museum environment.
- e. The bidder should ensure proper surface finishing & painting using appropriate paint as per site instructions to get required finish.
- f. The bidder should ensure the quality of Sculptural Models, Life-size or miniature scientific models, Thematic human figurines and sculptures.
- g. The artist or the modeler of the bidder should work in coordination with the designated officials from NSCD to maintain the quality and get the samples/modelling approved before casting.

4. General Instruction:

- a. Dimensions in the detailed drawings are to be followed during fabrication of the cabinets. Any variation found thereof should be brought to the notice of the authority and got approved by the concerned authority before finally fabricating and installing the cabinets at site.
- b. All the dimensions in the drawings are in millimeter unless otherwise specified.
- c. Please do not scale the drawings, as some parts of drawing may not be to the scale.
- d. All maintenance doors shall have proper teak wood framework, suitable size and number of hinges & handle and lock & key arrangements.
- e. No part of the screws/nails should project out of the cabinet surface, outside or inside. They shall be flushed completely to the surface.
- f. All the tools & tackles, instruments or any other devices/contrivances that are/may be required for proper and efficient execution of the fabrication job, shall be arranged

by the contractor only.

- g. Agency will be responsible for repainting all the areas of the wall where the exhibits are grouted or made dirty during the execution of work.
- h. In cases where the electrical sockets are mounted on concrete wall and FRP artwork is to be done on that wall, the electrical sockets will have to be moved out such that they make flush with the paneling.
- i. All the visible surfaces should have painted finish/polish finish/ corian finish.
- j. All the structures to be firmly supported from walls etc. as per direction at site.
- k. Proper eco-friendly anti termite chemical shall be applied on all wooden/plywood surfaces wherever applicable.
- l. All hinges and other hardware items like Telescopic sliders should be of Hettich make.
- m. All maintenance doors should flush with the existing structure.
- n. Use only Godrej make locks wherever doors are to be provided. The lock in a particular section should have a common key.
- o. Painting shall be done by applying PU primer with putty finish and finally 2 to 3 coats of 1st quality Synthetic PU paint of approved brand & shades.
